Introduction

The Pushover Driver provides with access to pushover.net's notification services

Highlighted Features

1. Send notification to all devices that are linked with Pushover.
2. Set notification priority.
3. Set notification sound.
4. Set notification title.

Requirements

The Driver has only been tested on Control4 OS2.1, OS2.4, and OS2.5. The Driver's compatibility on older operation systems is not guaranteed.

Driver Installation

Copy the Driver

1. Download and extract the .zip Driver files.
2. Copy the Driver file 'thedriverslab_pushover.c4i' to the Control4 Drivers' directory. The directory is typically located at My Documents\Control4\Drivers or Libraries\Documents\Control4\Drivers for Windows 7.
3. Launch the Composer Pro and connect to the Controller where the Driver will be installed.

Add the Driver to the Project

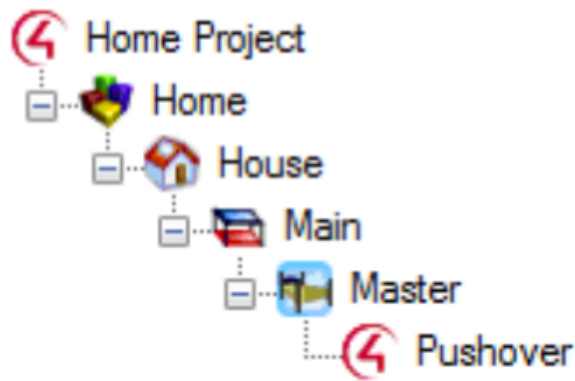
1. Select **System Design** on the left:



2. Select the **Search** tab on the right with Device Type -- **Other** -- and Manufacturer **TheDriversLab**:

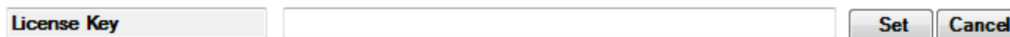


3. Double-click the **Pushover** Driver to add it to the Project.
4. The Driver will now appear in the Project as follows:



Configure the Driver

1. Click on the **Pushover** Driver on the left pane under System.
2. The Properties tab is located on the right.
3. Step one: enter the License Key.



4. Navigate to the Pushover website <https://pushover.net/login>:

5. Login or create an account.
6. Once logged in, the **User Key** will appear at the top right corner:

8. Back in the website, at the bottom of the page click on **Register an Application**:

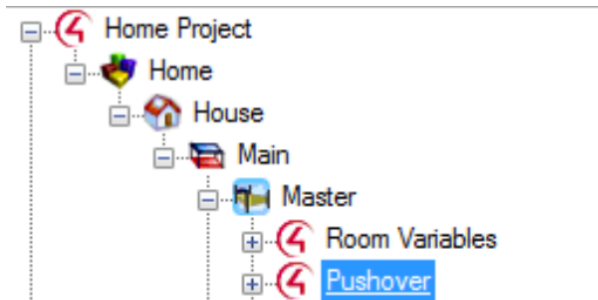


14. Under **Action** click **Send Test Notification** to confirm the installation was completed.

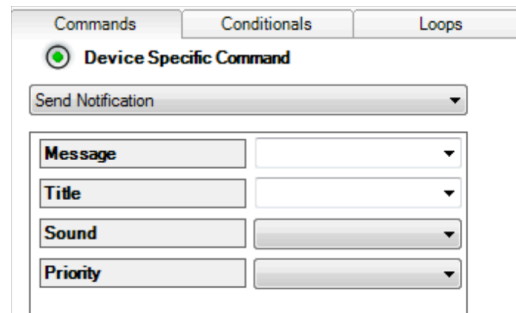


Programming

- Under Programming, in the right side select Pushover:

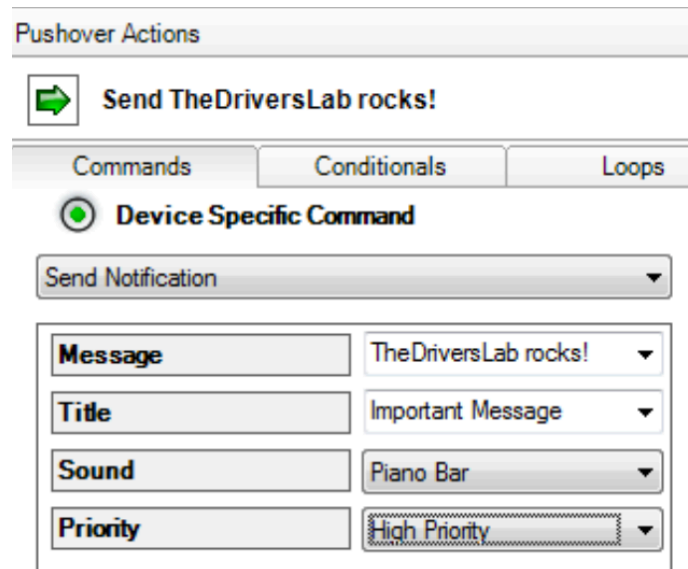


- Under Device Specific Commands select **Send Notification**:
